
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

This past year has been nothing short of remarkable. Because of you, our dedicated supporters and partners, we made incredible strides in advancing health care across Alberta.










Priority Areas


At Dulcina Hospice in St. Marguerite Manor, Calgary, the healing power of music brings peace and comfort to patients and their families through our music therapy program.

Women's and Children's Health



Fragile newborns go home sooner with advanced ventilators, women receive timely diagnoses and treatment through expanded colposcopy services, and underserved children gain the nourishment they need to learn and thrive through programs like the School Lunch Program.

Endobronchial Ultrasound Grey Nuns Community Hospital Specialty Training Initiative
