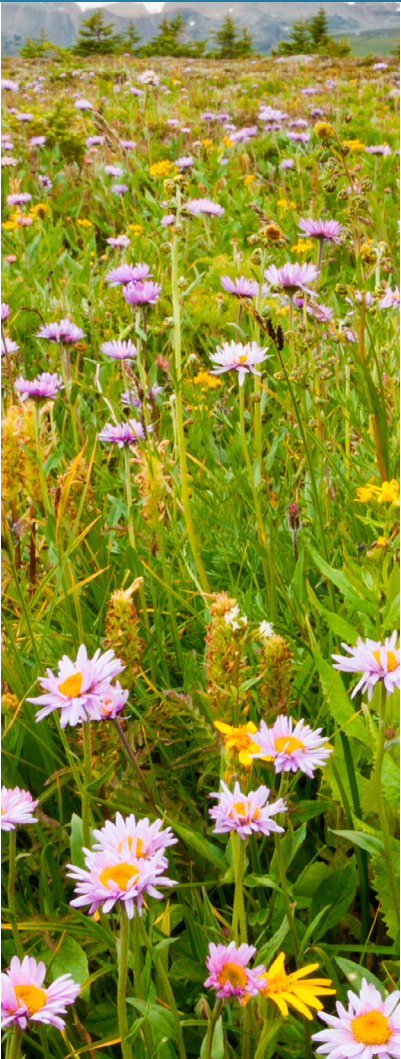
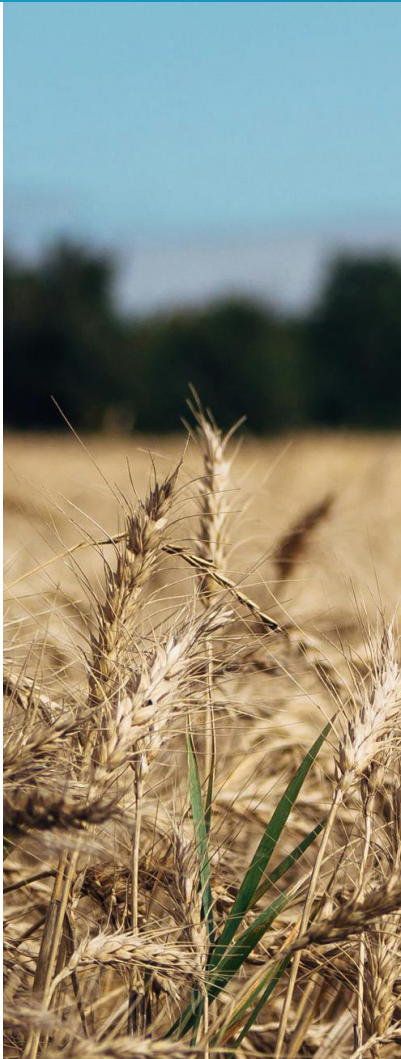

# Because of you

Because of you, **\$2.4M** was invested toward **105 grants** that improved quality of life for patients, residents, and families. A few examples are as follows:

## \$ 694K

funded the **Rural Mobile Simulation Project**, that trained healthcare teams so patients can receive the best care in their own communities

## \$ 250K

powered **Continuing Care innovation and technology**, giving residents more dignity, comfort, and independence every day

## \$ 202K+

purchased the **Fibreoptic Endoscopic Evaluation of Swallowing system**, preventing choking and aspiration so seniors can eat safely

## \$ 116K+

supported **innovative seniors' programming** which brought them connection, belonging, and better mental health

# Priority Areas

## Seniors' Health and Wellbeing

Because of you, the lives of seniors in Covenant's care were enriched. Patients benefitted from safer care with Centrella smart beds, healing programs like music therapy and Hearts for Music, and welcoming spaces such as community gardens. Together, we're setting new standards in quality of life for Alberta's seniors.



Because of you, the Centrella beds at St. Joseph's Home in Medicine Hat are providing residents with a good night's sleep.

## Palliative Care

Because of you, Covenant Foundation helps make Covenant a recognized leader in palliative care, proudly funding the Palliative Care Education and Research Conference, an annual event that brings together leaders and practitioners from across Alberta. Your gifts also supported in-home palliative beds and other comfort care initiatives that surround patients and families with holistic support in their final chapter.



At Dulcina Hospice in St. Marguerite Manor, Calgary, the healing power of music brings peace and comfort to patients and their families through our music therapy program.



# Priority Areas

## Mental Health and Addictions

Did you know that Villa Caritas is the only facility in Alberta focused solely on seniors' mental health? Because of you, their Serenity Courtyard and Serenity Murals are creating spaces that reduce stress and support their mental well-being. Alongside other mental health initiatives like Biking for Mental Health and creative art and healing programs, your generosity is enhancing whole-person care: body, mind and soul.



Because of you, patients at Villa Caritas have a calming gazebo where they can relax and experience the healing power of the outdoors.

## Rural Health

Because of you, Albertans in rural communities experienced care closer to home. The Mobile Simulation Project delivers hands-on, world-class training directly to rural health care teams, while programs like Meals on Wheels in Banff and new wellness equipment extend compassionate care into the community. Your support strengthens both staff expertise and patient comfort where resources can be limited.

# Priority Areas

## Women's and Children's Health

Did you know that one in five babies in Alberta are born in a Covenant hospital? Because of you, mothers, children and families are receiving care that saves lives and creates healthier futures. Fragile newborns go home sooner with advanced ventilators, women receive timely diagnoses and treatment through expanded colposcopy services, and underserved children gain the nourishment they need to learn and thrive through programs like the School Lunch Program.



A new state-of-the-art ventilator is now in use at the Misericordia Community Hospital, enabling fragile newborns to get home to their families sooner.

## Spiritual Health

Because of you, spiritual care remains a cornerstone of whole-person health care at Covenant. Your generosity made Covenant's first Indigenous Healing Garden possible, a sacred space for ceremony and reflection. You also revitalized chapels and multi-faith rooms, supported Indigenous cultural displays, and provided tools for daily prayer. These enhanced spaces and programs ensure patients, families, and staff find peace, belonging and meaning in every stage of care.



Because of you, Indigenous learning sessions are made possible in Covenant facilities like the Misericordia and Grey Nuns hospitals.



# Looking Ahead: Fiscal 2025-26

## Digital Wayfinding Lakewood Community Health Centre

This first-of-its-kind solution in Alberta will guide patients, visitors, and staff from home to the Lakewood Community Health Centre, then provide step-by-step directions inside the building – just like a GPS.

## Fabian Non-Invasive Ventilator Grey Nuns Community Hospital

This ventilator gently supports newborn babies' breathing using a mask instead of a breathing tube, making care more comfortable and less invasive.

## Multi-Sensory Therapy – Snoezelen Rover Buffalo Grace Manor, Lethbridge

This mobile Snoezelen unit will create a calming space with light, sound, music, and touch to reduce stress, frustration, and isolation, especially for residents with dementia or cognitive decline.



## Procedural Suites Misericordia Community Hospital

By shifting eligible surgeries to a new procedural suite, this initiative shortens hospital stays, reduces the need for general anesthesia, and improves recovery time.

## Indigenous Gathering Room Grey Nuns Community Hospital

This project funds supplies and resources for sacred ceremony, cultural awareness, and staff training. This helps ensure that Indigenous patients and families can practice traditions that support spiritual, emotional, and physical healing.

## Resident and Family Balconies St. Joseph's Auxiliary Hospital

This project will transform eight bare balconies into warm, inviting spaces with comfortable seating, flowers, and herbs, encouraging residents and families to enjoy more time outdoors.

These represent urgent needs in health care that will enhance the patient experience.
